**MINUTES**

Chairperson Gale Kleinkopf called the meeting to order at 11:07 am.

**Item #1 Approve minutes of the March 13<sup>th</sup>, 2013 meeting**

Helen Brown made a correction to meeting minutes, Gary Roland is Vice-Chairman not Brett Semple. Rich Birrell motioned to approve the meeting minutes with correction. Brett Semple seconded the motion. Motion passed with unanimous vote.

**Item #2 Fund Raising Golf Tournament Update**

Dennis revamped the letter that is being sent out to the sponsors by adding Brett Simple as the tournament chair person and indicated that in the past a list of projects was included. He recommended that we include that again and have a more definite list of what we are going to do with the proceeds.

Gale indicated that he wanted the Commission to come up with some ideas of what we need to include on the priority list and asked for input. Rich Birrell discussed the bridges on the creek and that they are in repair, there are holes at the bridges and it has been discussed to extend the concrete ramps to avoid the holes at the bridges. Steve indicated a need for tee box improvements, on hole 7 and on 11. Gale asked Dennis to indicate on the letter to sponsors

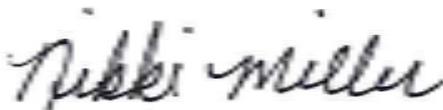
that tee boxes on 7 and 11 will be improved and continued work on the bunkers will be done. Helen indicated that the ladies had an executive meeting and they talked about all the work being done on the outside which benefits the ladies but the ladies are wanting some work done on the inside of the clubhouse. The ladies are indicating that they don't want to donate or golf in the tournament because none of the proceeds go to improving the inside of the clubhouse. She wants to get the ladies support and is not sure how to go about that. Dennis indicated that there has been some improvements in the restrooms and is going to budget for tables and chairs in the next budget year. The ladies restroom has been redone due to the water damage this winter. We have had to replace the ice machine in the kitchen. Steve is looking at extending the patio. Everyone benefits from the course improvements. The donors have leaned more to improving the course not the clubhouse. Perhaps we could come up with a miscellaneous fund set aside for some improvements for ladies. Helen will go back to the ladies and get their recommendations. Gale indicated that he would like to see some improvements on the cart paths as well, perhaps in the future. Dennis will rework the letter and get it out to the Commission so that they can start addressing donors. Brett asked the Commission to put together a list of people they would like address and then email Dennis and a complete list will be sent out to all the Commission.

**Item #3 Other Items from the Commission**

Dennis indicated that the ice maker in the kitchen has been replaced and that they are going to buy a couple more radios for Dario. Dennis is in the budget process and will be working with Steve to see what the needs are. We know some soffits on the clubhouse are in need of some work to keep the animals out.

The meeting was adjourned at 11:30 pm.
