TWIN FALLS GOLF ADVISORY COMMISSION MEETING

MINUTES

Chairperson Gale Kleinkopf called the meeting to order at 11:00 am.

- Item #1** **Approve minutes of the September 11th, 2013 meeting.**
Brett Semple motioned to approve meeting minutes, Jack Jardine seconded the motion. Motion passed with a unanimous vote.
- Item #2** **Fund Raising Golf Tournament Update**
Steve reported that he received a bill for sand in the amount of \$2100 which leaves \$5400 for improvements. Dario has not received bids back for the concrete for the cart paths. Discussion on where to spend the remaining funds transpired. Chairman Kleinkopf would like to see visibility of the work done from the use of the funds. There are not enough funds to completely do the cart paths at this time. Discussion on getting Tee box #11 done, Steve indicated it would cost a \$1000 for the sod. Dario is working on the 18th green and should have it done within the next four days with no cost to us. Brett got a cost on concrete of \$300 a yard (8x10). We have enough money to do about 166 feet of concrete. Chairman Kleinkopf asked Steve to email him what can be done on concrete, what are the exact measurements and

what can be done with funds available once he gets his estimates and they will decide at that time what will take place.

Item #3 Proposed Fee Increases

Steve reviewed the proposed fee increase. Season passes for Adult single, Adult couple, Senior single and couple will go up \$20.00. Adult w/child will go up \$1.50. Greens fees for Adult, weekday/weekend will go up \$1.00. The increases stayed under 5% and do not have to go to Council for approval. The Mayor does have to sign a resolution stating the new fees for the golf course if approved.

Discussion followed on the pros and cons of the proposed increases.


Rich Birrell motioned to approve the fee increases as stated, Helen Brown seconded the motion. Motion passed with a unanimous vote.
