MINUTES

Vice-Chairperson Jack Jardine called the meeting to order at 11:10 am.

Item # 1 Approve minutes of the May 14, 2014 meeting

Rich Birrell motioned to approve the May 14, 2014 meeting minutes and Dusti Becker seconded the motion. Motion was unanimously approved.

Item #2 “Friends of Muni” Fundraising Tournament

Dennis reminded us that the Hiskey Family will have about 40 players there and they would like to have the morning tee time. Nikki updated the Sponsor Letter that is front and back and she will email this out to everyone. Steve indicated that the posters and raffle tickets are done. Steve

asked that if you have teams already signed up to get that information to him right away. Nikki will mail out letters to those we have information on.

Jack had some suggestions in regards to the raffle. The grill is already out at the Golf Course, there are four golf bags, one will be at the Dairy Queen on Blue Lakes with a sign on it, and perhaps we could hang the other three from the balcony with the same sign. Jack also recommended having the employees at the golf course to sell raffle tickets for a commission. Teena has a quilt that is being donated from Kathy Graves. Every square on this quilt has something cute in regards to golfing. Several people want to get in on this quilt but they only want to buy a raffle for the quilt. We need to figure out how to handle this quilt. Silent auction, separate tickets or separate raffle.

The Commissioners did not want to do the commission to the employees at the Golf Course. Steve indicated that some people coming in really don't want to be bothered when they are in the clubhouse. We do need to make an effort at the Golf Course to get some teams or donations together.
