_____ shall be responsible for all weed control on all lands within the boundary of the _____ Subdivision. Weed control shall follow the following measures:

1. Within areas under current development stage, all controls shall be in conjunction with the pollution prevention plan. Portions of those areas that will be undisturbed will be tilled and seeded in accordance with the pollution prevention plan.
2. Underdeveloped areas will be handled in one of the following manners:
 - a) In irrigated areas normal agricultural practices shall be maintained.
 - b) In non-irrigated areas land will be mowed as needed to lower the weed growth to no more than 6". Land may also be tilled or disked to remove growth provided the city has approved a dust abatement program for the land.
 - c) In non-irrigated areas that will undergo intermittent activity due to equipment storage, off-site utility construction, site access, etc. the weed control plan shall be as follows:
3. From March to April, once vegetation has established, weeds will be identified and sprayed with an approved herbicide. Application will take place during a two-week time frame in which forecasts predict optimum application conditions of no expected rainfall and low wind conditions. After one to two weeks of application of weed kill the land shall be mowed. Regular mowing shall then be accomplished as often as needed.
