



Twin Falls City Pool Rules



- All patrons must shower before entering the pool.
- Those having an infectious or communicable disease are prohibited from using the pool.
- Persons having open blisters or cuts are advised not to use the pool.
- Street clothing is prohibited in the pool. Patrons using the pool must wear appropriate swim attire (Polyester and Lycra). Cotton is prohibited.
- **Children must be within arm's reach of an adult that is 5 feet tall if they are:**
 - **5 years of age and younger. These children must also wear a red wristband on their wrist at all times.**
 - **5 & under and pass the swim test. They can go in the deep end if an adult is with them in the water. They must wear a red and green wristband.**
 - **Using a flotation device.**
- Children under 15 must pass the swim test to go into the deep end.
- Children under 15 are prohibited from doing back flips off the diving board.
- Water wings are prohibited; all flotation devices are prohibited in the deep-end.
- Oversized inflatables are prohibited.
- Inverted dives, gainers and multi-bouncing are prohibited on the diving board.
- Diving is prohibited in water less than 10 feet deep. Tricks are prohibited on the side.
- No extended underwater breath holding (10 seconds or longer) or hyperventilating.
- Only foam sport balls are allowed in the pool.
- Mermaid tails and mono fins are prohibited. Fins are prohibited on the deck.
- Starting blocks in the lap lanes are for proper use only.
- No more than 1 child on the slide at a time. Children must go down the slide feet first.
- Patrons must share lanes.
- Horse play, bullying, gum, band aids, spitting, and PDA are prohibited in the pool.
- Food and drink is only permitted in designated picnic areas.
- Pets are prohibited. Service animals are permitted in designated areas.
- Alcohol, tobacco, and firearms are strictly prohibited.
- The lifeguards are charged with ensuring everyone's safety and enforcing rules.
